

# KNOW YOUR RIGHTS!



Education, food, health care, shelter, emergency services, IDNYC, and ActionNYC (the City's free immigration legal services program) are available regardless of status.

You have a right to free language services. Free interpretation services are available at City agencies that provide direct public services. Interpretation is available in over 180 languages.

Your information is private and confidential. City agencies will only ask for confidential information if it is needed in order to determine eligibility for services, or if it is required by law. The information you share will be kept private and protected in line with the City's laws and rules.

NYPD officers will not ask about your immigration status if you are the victim of a crime, a witness, or seeking help from the police. NYPD officers are not Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).

Birds migrate (move homes) like people do. They migrate here from all over the world, like New Yorkers! We are like the beautiful birds on these maps.

Every child has the right to attend public school, regardless of immigration status, national origin, or religion. New York City public schools do not track immigration status of students and families, and will not release student information. Schools do not allow Federal immigration agents to enter, unless absolutely necessary.

Our commitment to our immigrant communities is stronger than ever. We will never turn our back on you.
